Arrival & Dismissal Car Line

We have what Mrs. Kutz calls a "Goldilocks Problem" with arrival and dismissal. Some students arrive too early, some arrive too late, and some arrive just on time! Students may not be dropped off until 7:20am but need to arrive before 7:55am. We try to move the line as quick as we can, but we need your help. Left turns when exiting campus during arrival and dismissal slows the process, do not do it. Parents are expected to use School Dismissal Manager during dismissal or when they are changing a student's going home. All changes need to be completed in the system by 1:10pm.
